Top 20% of the teams will bowl two Baker games after the three regular games.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. A team shall consist of two bowlers from the Ann Arbor 700 Club, Chapter #25 who will bowl three (3) regular games. The top 20% (plus one, if necessary to make an even number of teams) will then bowl two Baker games with handicap (alternating player position each game). Teams will be paired for the Baker games according to their three regular games total score with handicap.
2. High qualifying team will earn \$40 team prize. Final standings will be based on the total pins with handicap for the three regular games and the two baker games with handicap.
3. Open only to current members of the Ann Arbor Association 700 Club Chapter #25. All bowlers must be USBC members. Those bowlers who are not yet USBC members may buy an associate membership card (\$18.00) or pay the participation fee (\$5.00). All fees must accompany the entry.
4. Everyone will use his or her highest sanctioned yearbook average from the 2009-2010 season from any sanctioned league of 21 games or more. If no last year's average, you will use your average (21 games or more) as of the time of bowling, including summer averages. (All others will bowl from 225 Scratch.)
5. Team handicap will be 90% of the difference between team average and 450.
6. **Maximum entering team average is 450.**
7. USBC Rule 319a-2, Ten Pin Rule will not apply.
8. USBC Rule 319a-3, failure to use the correct average or make correction prior to completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.
9. USBC Rule 319d Prize Winnings reporting will not apply.
10. USBC Rule 319e regarding re-rating will not apply.
